

# Preparing Indigenous Teachers and Administrators for Alaska's Schools PITAAS SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION **School Year 2016-2017**

PITAAS is a teacher preparation program for Alaska Natives at the University of Alaska Southeast. The PITTAS program began in 2000 by the University of Alaska Southeast with the help of a federal grant to address the shortage of Alaska Native teachers. Students who are accepted into this program receive scholarship funds that cover University of Alaska Southeast tuition, fees, and books. Scholarships amounts vary by year depending on grant funding (\$356A140048).

### Eligible students:

- Alaska Native.
- o Committed to becoming a teacher or administrator in the State of Alaska.
- o Enrolled in a qualifying education program **at UAS**.

### Qualifying education programs include:

- o B.A. in Elementary Education and Special Education (Must be junior standing to be eligible.)
- Secondary B.L.A. (Must be junior standing to be eligible.)
- o Master's of Arts in Teaching; Elementary, Secondary or Special Education
- o Master's Degrees in Education; Educational Leadership, Superintendent Certificate, Education Technology, Mathematics Education (K-8), Reading Specialist, or Special Education.
- K 8, Superintendent Endorsement

Students must maintain a minimum Grade Point Average of 3.0 or higher to continue receiving the scholarship once in the program and awarded. Progress reports must be submitted following mid-terms to verify current grade standing.
