

INSTALLING & CONFIGURING FIREFTP FOR UASHOME ACCESS

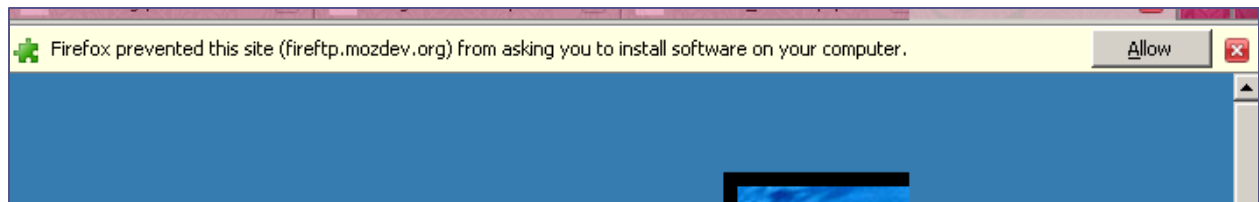
These instructions will help you set up your computer to access your UASHome through FTP with Core FTP Lite. Core FTP Lite can be used to access and upload contents into your UASHome space.

These instructions were written based on a machine running Microsoft XP. If your computer uses a different operating system, the images or instructions may vary slightly.

STEP 1

Make sure you've installed the FireFTP add-on into Firefox. The add-on can be downloaded from the developer's webpage here: <http://fireftp.mozdev.org/>.

Firefox may try to block the add-on from downloading:

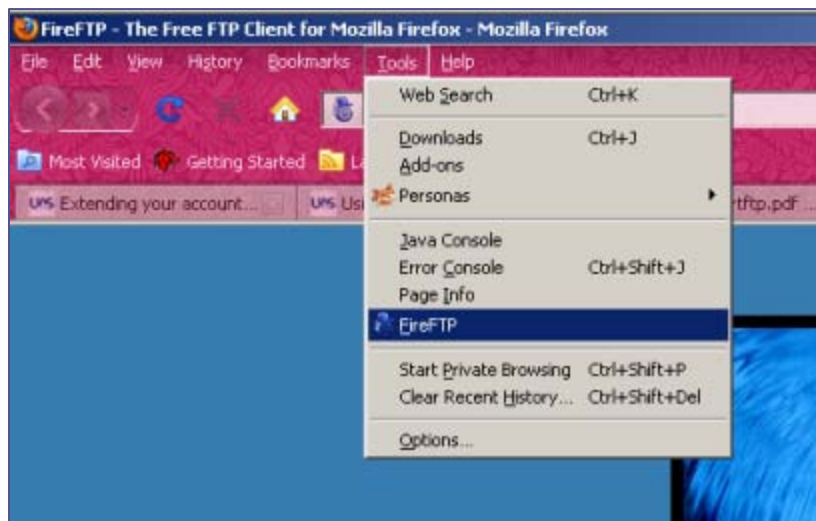


Press "Allow". A popup should then come up asking if you want to install. Press "Install Now". Once it's installed, restart Firefox.

STEP 2

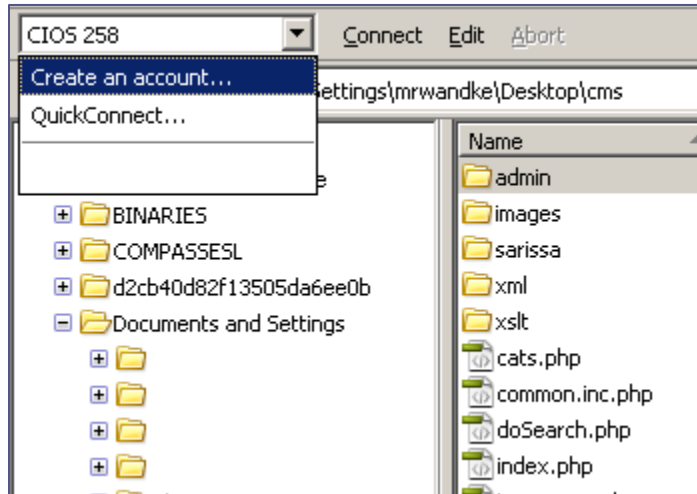
Open FireFTP by going to Tools in the top menu bar of Firefox.

Click on "FireFTP".



STEP 3

FireFTP will open in a new window. Click on the drop-down box within the upper left corner of FireFTP to create an account.



STEP 4

For Host, enter: **uashome.alaska.edu**.

For Login, enter your UA username.

For Password, enter your password.

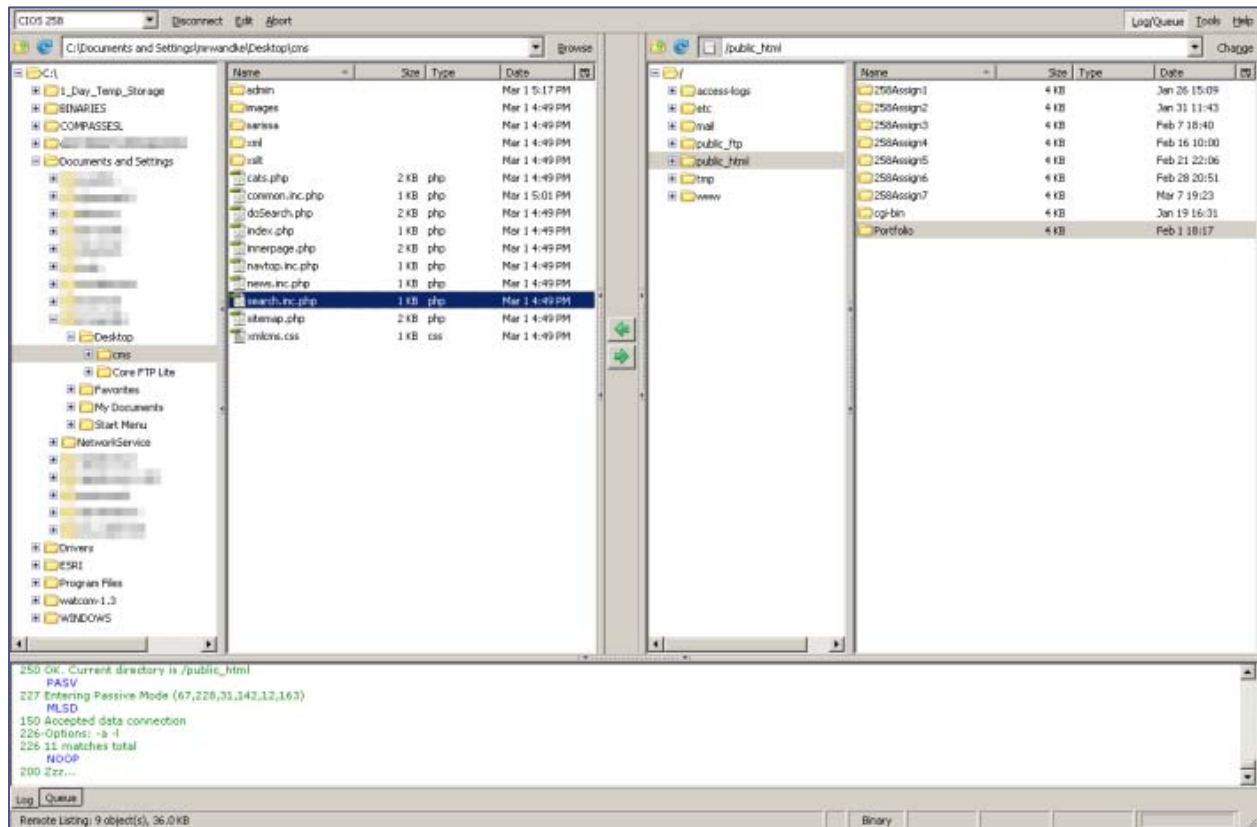
You can name the account whatever you prefer.

Click **“OK”**.



STEP 5

Click “Connect”, and all of the files in your home space will be displayed. You can drag and drop the files between your hard drive and home space. You can also right click on files in the home space (CTRL+Click on Mac) to save them to your hard drive.
