### **Eligibility:**

*Summit* will consider submissions from any current undergraduate student taking courses through any of the three UAS campuses.

## **Accepted Works:**

Due to the nature of the journal, *Summit* will only be accepting academic works that meet the following criteria:

- Qualify as academic (no creative works)
- Do not exceed 15 pages (double spaced), excluding references
- Present a clear thesis

### **Scoring:**

Each submission will be judged with the same rubric, which analyzes each paper for how well they reflect scholarly writing and the UAS core competencies of:

- Information literacy
- Critical thinking
- Professional behavior reflected in writing

# **Essay Contest:**

The paper that exhibits the strongest mastery of the core competencies will be the recipient of the UAS Ernestine Hayes Award for Excellence in Essay Writing, be featured with a special spread in the journal, and win a monetary prize.

#### **How to Submit:**

- 1. Fill out the attached cover sheet (on the second page of this file)
- 2. Write a short author bio (50-80 words) in the third person and include on a separate page at the beginning of your submission
- 3. Ensure that your essay is in Times New Roman, size 12 font, double-spaced
- 4. Send an electronic word.doc, .docx, or Pages document to the Writing Center email: <a href="mailto:uas.writingcenter@alaska.edu">uas.writingcenter@alaska.edu</a>. In the subject line of your email, please include "Writing Center Journal Submission." We will not accept .pdf documents or physical copies.
