


Alaska's Postsecondary Attainment Goal

We have poor attainment & completion rates — in the US and Alaska.

US is 11th in Global Postsecondary Attainment



Alaska is 49th in Postsecondary Completion



Our education levels to not match job market needs.

U.S. (Georgetown Center on Education and the Workforce)

 By 2020, two-thirds of new jobs will require some form of postsecondary education.
Today, about 45% of adults in the US have achieved that level of education.

Alaska (DOL)

 By 2025, 65% of Alaska's fastest growing high-wage jobs will require some form of postsecondary education. Today, 43% of adults in Alaska have achieved that level of education.

So we have attainment goals

U.S.: By 2025, 60% of Americans will high-quality degrees, certificates and other postsecondary credentials – in order to meet workforce needs.

Alaska: 65% of Alaskan adults will have a credential or postsecondary degree by 2025.








The gap is larger in communities of color

National Alaska


Degree-attainment rates among United States residents (ages 25-64), by population group








Attainment efforts must address racial equity
