Purpose:

Application Process:

Applicants will be evaluated using the following criteria:

1. Thoroughness and thoughtfulness of answers to essay questions. (50%)
2. Attention to detail and completeness of the application. (50%)

Notes:

- Upon selection of scholarship awardees, an email will be sent to notify applicants of their status. Please make certain to provide an email address that is active and correct.
- Scholarship funds will be disbursed directly to UAS student accounts upon registration.
- Tours of one of the Juneau mines are included as part of class content for students who have successfully completed the course, though completely optional. For students outside of Southeast Alaska, roundtrip airfare between Juneau and the nearest community served by Alaska Airlines is provided to successful scholarship awardees. Tours are tentatively scheduled for the end of May and are at the discretion of Hecla Greens Creek Mining Company and Coeur Alaska – Kensington
