From that, students asked if there could be an effort, in conjunction with staff/faculty, to address these issues. Heather and Kolene are working with the students to develop a plan (based on their comfort and interests)—to connect students with DEICS committee and CACANE to share experiences in a safe space, like a student fishbowl exercise. From there, students will determine where they want to go next (perhaps related to an event at convocation, and perhaps in connection with Title IX). Volunteers to help with this effort and attend the student groups are welcome (Fridays 1-2pm; send an email to Kolene)!
  - X'unei: While it's not the responsibility of this committee to take action, it does become more of our job to act when the university fails to take responsibility. The University needs to stop the pattern of Institutionalized Racism. Kolene agrees and thanks X'unei. Math invites them to join again.
