First Readings

16-38: Business administration AAS. Category A Curriculum Change. Major changes to this degree. Initiating faculty member – Maren Haavig.

17-01: Biology BA. Category B Curriculum Change. Inclusion of a Marine Fisheries Emphasis.

17-02: Biology BS. Category B Curriculum Change. Inclusion of a Marine Fisheries Emphasis.

17-03: Marine Biology BS. Category B Curriculum Change. Inclusion of a Marine Fisheries Emphasis.

All three of 17-01 thru 17-03 have been proposed by Carolyn Bergstrom. The Biology program is seeking conditional approval of these proposals, subject to successful faculty hires currently in progress. See supporting documents addressing these proposals.
