After you complete the appropriate form, UAS faculty will review it. If we discover areas of deficiency, we will work with you to develop a plan to deepen your content knowledge in required areas.

- 1. To complete one of the forms you will need access to all of your undergraduate and graduate transcripts. These can be unofficial copies as long as they indicate your final grade. Courses where you received an incomplete or failing grade should not be listed.
- 2. You only need to complete the form in the area you are seeking certification.
- 3. Please list the courses that are relevant to each standard or area. It is not necessary that the course title states explicitly the standards listed for the content area. For instance, a calculus course that covers more than one of the standards can be listed more than once.
- 4. If you don't recall the specific course content for courses, please refer to the catalog course descriptions when possible.
- 5. After you have completed the form, please save a copy for your records. Then email the completed form along with unofficial copies of your transcript(s) to the program advisor, Dr. Elaine Alvey, at: ealvey@alaska.edu. After you have received feedback from the advisor on your form, use the feedback to make updates to the form (if recommended) and submit to Admissions: uas.admissions@alaska.edu.
