Re: Fall 2007 Semester Closing Enrollment

Enrolled student headcount decreased by 2.0% from last fall to 32,166, a loss of 670 students across the system. Systemwide, the number of SCH and FTE decreased 1.1% over the same time period.

The system-level 5-year enrollment trend (2003-2007) shows a 5.1% drop in student headcount while SCH and FTE have each increased very slightly (0.2%). This reflects a shift in the type of students who are enrolling at the University from part-time to full-time students. Since fall 2003, the proportion of full-time students has increased by 2.4%, while the proportion of part-time students has decreased by 9.2%.

Enrollment trends between fall 2006 and fall 2007 varied by MAU, with student headcount decreasing 1.2% at UAA and 10.4% at UAS, and remaining steady at UAF. During the same period, FTE and SCH declined at all MAUs, decreasing 0.3% at UAA, 0.6% at UAF, and 7.6% at UAS. Below is a table of the percentage change in headcount, FTE, and SCH by MAU since last fall.

Enrollment at the main campuses fluctuated between fall 2006 and fall 2007, with headcount increasing by 1.8% (+267) at Anchorage campus, and decreasing by 1.7% (-91) at Fairbanks campus and 12.5% (-246) at Juneau campus. At the community campus level, where enrollment is typically more volatile than at the larger main campuses, some locations experienced substantial gains, and others substantial losses. Decreases were seen at all UAA community campuses, with the most significant decrease at PWSCC (-23.2%, a loss of 369). At UAF community campuses, enrollment patterns varied. There were large increases in headcount at

Northwest (+44.4%, 160) and Bristol Bay (+27.8%, 147), while enrollment at Kuskokwim campus dropped substantially (-22.2%, -86). Other UAF community campuses experienced moderate decreases. At UAS, Ketchikan enrolled 10.6% fewer students (-57) than in fall 2006, while headcount at Sitka increased by 10% (+76).

Additional fall 2007 enrollment highlights follow:

- ❖ The number of first-time freshman enrolling in the UA system is down 2.4% (-71) since last fall. A nearly 6% gain (+53 students) at UAF was offset by losses at UAA (-4.3%, -82) and UAS (-22.5%, -43). However, the number of first-time graduate students attending UA increased 13.3% (+50) since fall 2006, with gains at UAS (+83.3%), UAA (+9.1%) and UAF (+5.4%).
- ❖ Across the UA system, the percentage of non-degree seeking students remained stable from last fall.
- ❖ The number of UA Scholars attending the University increased by 90 students since fall 2006, for a total of 1,793 Scholars enrolled this fall. There were 416 new UA Scholars receiving the scholarship for the first time this fall.
- ❖ Since last fall, the number of Alaska Native students attending the University decreased by 131 (-3.1%). Enrollment of Hispanics and Asians increased (+3.6%, 43, and 1.8%, 33 respectively), while enrollment declined among both white (-3.3%, -737) and black (-3.1%, -31) students.

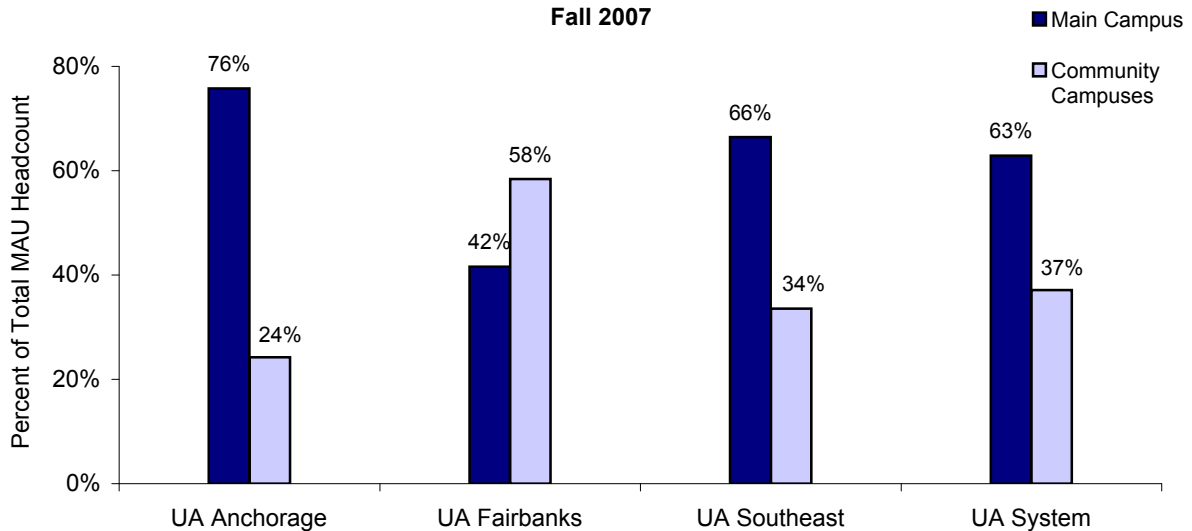

Fall 2007**



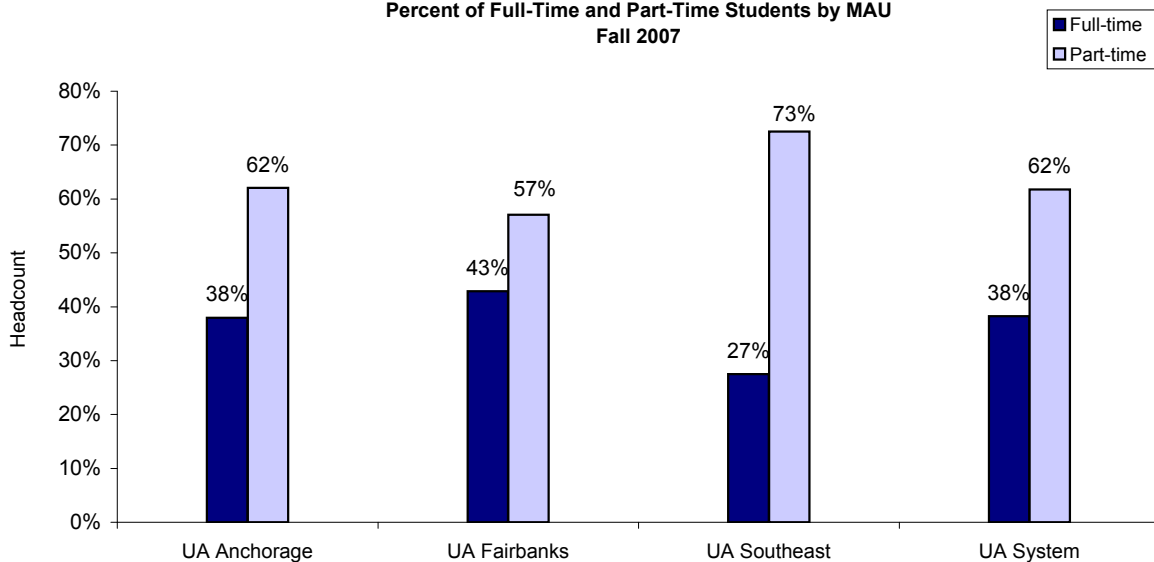

- 1) part-time at the MAU and system level;
- 2) full-time at the system level but part-time at the MAU level (indicated by inclusion in the 'UA full-time' headcount); or
- 3) full-time at the system and MAU levels (indicated by inclusion in the 'MAU full-time' headcount).

For example:

- 1) An undergraduate enrolled for a total of 12 SCH, 9 at Fairbanks and 3 at Anchorage, would be included in the UA full-time count for UA Fairbanks and the UA full-time count for UA Anchorage.
- 2) An undergraduate enrolled for a total of 15 SCH, 12 at Juneau and 3 at Fairbanks would be included in the MAU full-time count for UA Southeast and in the UA full-time count for UA Fairbanks.
- 3) A part-time student is included in the part-time counts at each MAU where the student is enrolled.

For example:

An undergraduate enrolled for a total of 12 SCHs, 9 at Fairbanks and 3 at Tanana Valley, is included in the full-time UA system count for Fairbanks and the full-time UA system count for Tanana Valley.

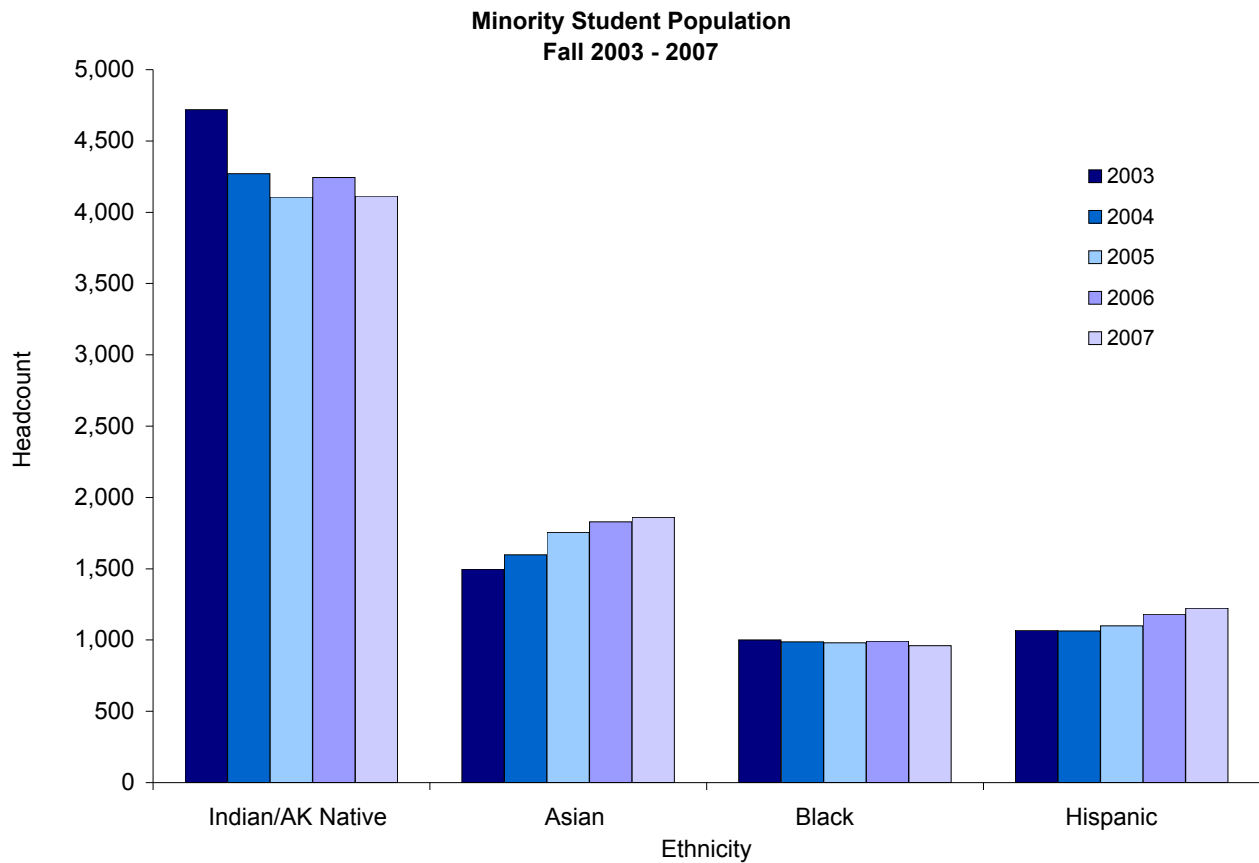
An undergraduate enrolled for a total of 15 SCHs, 3 at Anchorage and 12 at Kodiak is included in the full-time campus/MAU count for Kodiak and in the full-time UA system count for Anchorage.

A graduate student enrolled for a total of 6 SCH, 3 at Juneau and 3 at Fairbanks, is included in the part-time counts at both campuses/MAUs.

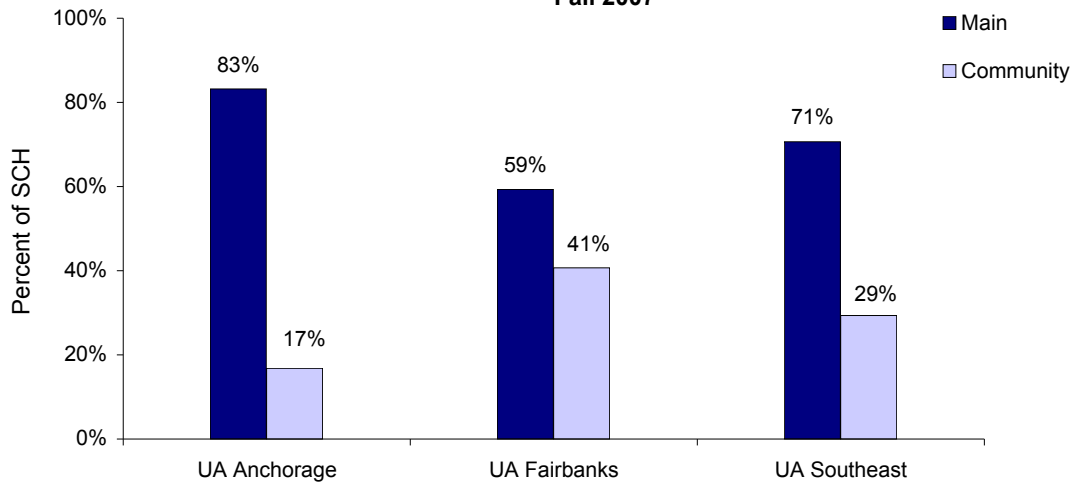

Fall 2007**



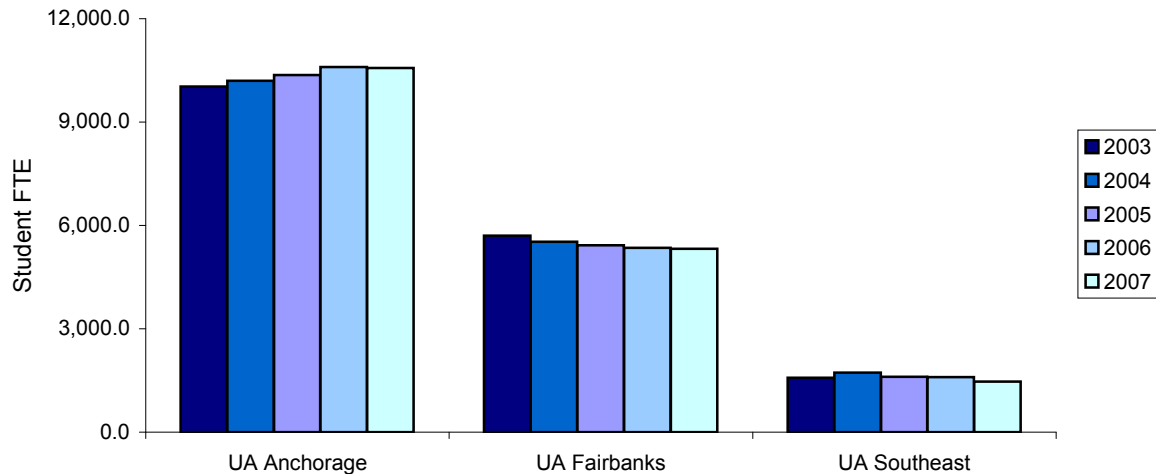

Student FTE by MAU

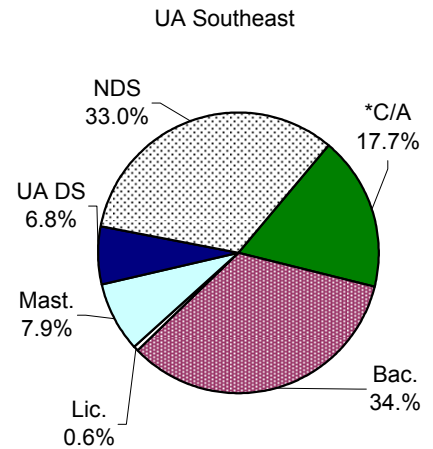
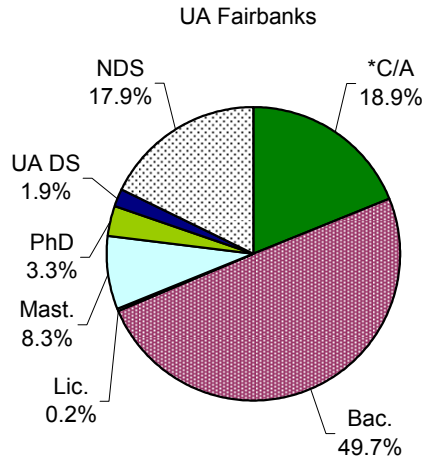
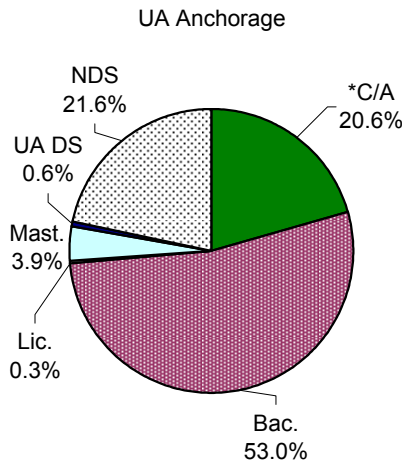
