7.4 Recommendation for continuance or discontinuance.							
The BLA is the only baccalaureate program with the School of Arts and Sciences at UAS designed for students seeking a broad-based education. It admits more students to the program than any other BA or BS degree program with A&S (including transfer, non-traditional, and distance students), yet the BLA program is in an extreme state of institutional crisis with no departmental home, few designated faculty, no independently designated institutional resources, and an ill-defined General Studies degree with no assessment plan. The future health of the BLA depends directly upon implementing the recommendations, above. Given the large number of students currently admitted to the BLA degree program, its continuance is imperative. II.
