In order for the Financial Aid Office to consider you an Unaccompanied Homeless Youth for financial aid purposes, you must complete this form and submit the following:

- I. Attach a signed personal letter requesting the determination or continuation of your unaccompanied homeless youth status. The letter must update your family circumstances and include the following information:
- At any time on or after July 1, 2022 were you considered to be homeless? (outside of living in student housing/dorms)
  - What were your (and parents) living arrangements over the past year?
  - Who has provided support to you during the past year?
- II. Two signed letters from a third party (on letterhead) attesting to your homeless situation. This can include a homeless shelter or service provider, health or mental health professional, social worker, counselor, employer, mentor, UAS staff or faculty, etc.

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**Who are Unaccompanied Homeless Youth?** Unaccompanied homeless youth are those under age 21 who lack safe, stable homes and who are not in the care of a parent or guardian. They may have run away from home or been forced to leave by their parents. Unaccompanied youth live in a variety of temporary situations, including shelters, the homes of friends or relatives, cars, campgrounds, public parks, abandoned buildings, motels, and bus or train stations.

**Who are McKinney-Vento School District Liaisons?** Under subtitle VII-B of the McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act, every district is required to designate a liaison for students experiencing homelessness. Homeless liaisons have a number of legal responsibilities under the Act, including identifying youth who meet the definition of homeless and are unaccompanied. **What are HUD-funded Shelters?** The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) administers funding for homeless shelters and services under Title IV of the McKinney-Vento Act. **What are RHYA-funded Shelters?** The U.S. Department of Health and Human Services administers the Runaway and Homeless Youth Act programs.
