We redirected our resources to maintain essential services and resources, notably by eliminating a major contract with OCLC. A spending freeze at the beginning of FY20 and the conditions imposed by the pandemic led to a sharp decrease in non-essential expenditures in the areas of equipment and furniture replacement, event programming, and travel. |             |          |         |
