WINTER WEATHER TIPS:

As a reminder, please use care when walking on the housing sidewalks and pathways, particularly in the mornings. Facilities crew will do their best to keep up with snow removal, but sometimes this can be delayed. Buckets of Ice Melt are being placed by units and are available for your use, as needed.

University Drive is maintained by the city plows and can sometimes be challenging to get up and down depending on snow removal. As a worst case scenario, students can park at the Rec Center and walk up to campus from the trial.

Yaktrax work wonders in these conditions and can be purchased for relatively cheap at Fred Meyers or Sportsman's Wearhouse.

Need to shovel out your car? The desk locations have shovels for residents to use. Please return them promptly as soon as you're done using them so that others can use them. Additionally, they have some gravel for use if you need to gain traction for spinning wheels.

The cooler temperatures can also cause more condensation in units (particularly ground floor ones.) Please ensure that your heat is on and that **windows are not left open** for extended periods of time - especially overnight!

Steps for a successful check-out of UAS Housing...

SIGN UP FOR A CHECKOUT INSPECTION

This must be done at least 24 hours in advance to avoid a \$50 improper checkout fee. If you have a late night flight, a checkout can be completed at the latest possible time the night prior. The space should still be cleaned for the inspection.

WHAT TO EXPECT:

At the time of your appointment, a staff member will meet you at your unit. You MUST BE PRESENT to avoid a \$50 improper check-out fee. The staff will walk with you through the unit to verify that the bedroom and common spaces are ready to sit over the winter break. At the end of the inspection, you should be prepared to turn in your room and mail keys.

HAVE A CLEAN SPACE

Ensure that trash and old food is thrown out in your bedroom, the fridge, and other common areas. If you have an assignment for the Spring, you can leave your belongings in the unit. If you are moving out, the space must be empty.

CONSERVE ENERGY

Shut and lock windows and unplug nonessential items (Fridge should stay plugged in.)

BRING YOUR ANIMALS

Owners may not leave their animals with a roommate, nor may the animal stay in another unit - with the exception of fish. Automated fish feeders are recommended.

VEHICLE

If you are leaving a vehicle over break, it must be moved to the spot designated in winter break email to avoid towing..
