Holiday Events-Halloween event proposed for the 26th. Activities proposed will be face/pumpkin painting, Costume contests for both children and adults (with prizes), games?



Thanksgiving-Team oriented food drive proposed with prizes for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place for teams. Chris T to look for possible prizes.



NOTES:

1. Went over the previous weeks' suggestions for events. We will be doing events that alternate on Thursdays. Wii nights-1st and 3rd Thursday with Poker nights on the 2nd and 4th Thursdays. Food handling rules will need to be researched to avoid having to get food handler cards.
