Highlights

- Revenue increased by \$27,365.72 from FY17
- Expenses increased by \$93,500.10 from FY17
- The windows in the Lakeside Grill and Lakeside Store pantry area facing Auke Lake were
 replaced in summer 2017. The rest of the windows in the cafeteria and store will be replaced
 summer 2018. The new windows allow increased natural light and make better use of the
 cafeteria and store's view of Auke Lake.
- New hanging lights were installed over the hotline in fall 2017.
- The Bear's Pantry location was closed and pantry items consolidated to the Lakeside Store.
- Dining transitioned to using biodegradable or compostable containers for hot to-go containers, salad bar containers, and grab-n-go food cups.

Catering Fee Structure

In spring 2018 Dining Services reviewed and updated the catering menu and fee structure to improve cost-effectiveness and increase timely payments. The new menu and fee structure went into effect June 1, 2018.

- Order Deadline: Catering orders are due 2 weeks before the event. Requests received less than 2 weeks before an event will incur an additional fee of 5% of total charges, up to a maximum of \$50.00
- Payment Deadline: Payment is due within two weeks of the date of service or date of final invoice, whichever is later. Invoices not paid in full within this time period will incur a fee of 5% of total charges per week until paid in full.
- After Hours Catering: Catering falling outside of the normal Dining Services business day incurs
 additional costs for staffing. To recoup these costs an additional fee of \$50.00 per hour will be
 incurred for catering events outside these hours. After hours are defined as follows:
 - o Monday Friday: Before 7:00am, After 8:00pm
 - Saturday Sunday: Before 9:00am, After 8:00pm






YOY Expenditures




YOY Lakeside Grill & Spike's Café Revenue

Assessment Initiatives

In FY19 Dining Services plans to request to add a ballot measure on the Student Government fall elections to gauge student interest in installing Coke or Pepsi soda fountains to replace the current bottled soda options. Dining also plans to conduct mid-year and end-of-year student surveys to collect information on student satisfaction, needs, and other comments.

Personnel

In FY18 Dining Services had a total of 7 full-time staff including 1 Dining Manger, 1 Administrative Assistant (resigned in July 2017, position filled July 2017), and 4 Cooks. In addition to the full-time staff 3 temporary staff cooks were hired. Of Dining's 12 student employees hired throughout the year 8 were returning staff.



Percentage of Academic Year sales by hour




Percentage of Academic Year sales by hour

ATM Vendor

The ATM in the Lakeside Grill is owned and operated by Alaska Cache Liquor, Inc. The vendor is responsible for stocking and maintaining the ATM and UAS provides internet connection and a secure location for the ATM. UAS receives a portion of the proceeds after transactions reach a certain volume per month. This transaction volume was not reached in FY18.

Graduation Gear Vendor

In FY18 the management and sales of graduation gear was handed from the Student Accounts office to Dining Services. Dining Services partners with Jostens to provide online graduation gear sales at a low cost to students, as well as keeping a small stock of items on hand for last minute sales.

Vending Machines

The two vending machines in the Egan building owned by Dining Services have not been operational during FY18. Dining Services is currently in the process of negotiating for Odom Corporation (Coca Cola) to take over the vending machine locations. The new vending machines would have the capabilities to take credit card and campus card payments. The new machines are expected to be installed by the fall 2018 semester.

Online Apparel Store

Work on an online apparel store continued through FY18. The store is hosted through TouchNet, and the Dining Services Admin will be responsible for inventory management and order fulfillment. The store is expected to launch in August, 2018.

Lakeside Convenience Store

The Lakeside Convenience Store was closed over summer 2017 to facilitate partial window replacement and painting of the space. Merchandise was consolidated and reduced to make space for new logo wear, and to open up the layout of the shelving in the store. A space was made to sell snacks and food staples due to the closure of the Bear's Pantry location. In summer 2018 the store was closed to finish the window replacement project.

Spike's Café Improvements

Improvements to the area of Spike's Café are being planned, possibly including new seating, lighting, wall decorations, rugs, and improved signage.
