Creating a Blackboard Guest Sign In

You need a guest login to preview courses and visit the sample Blackboard: Behind the Scenes course. This short tutorial will explain the steps you need to complete.

Locate the Guest Sign In






(1) Navigate to UAS Online http://uas.alaska.edu/online. (2) Click on the Guest Sign In link.

Click on "New User" to create your account.



You must click on new user to get your email address into our Blackboard system.

Getting your email into our system




(1) You must enter your complete email address. Our system will send you a password so that you can log into our Blackboard system in a few minutes. You will have to check your email to retreive this password. (2) Click "Sign up"

Retreive Your Password



(1) You should see a screen like this one telling you that the system has sent a password to the email address which you entered. (2) Log into your email and retreive the password that the system sent to you. (3) Type that password into the password box. Be sure to check your spam. Sometimes this email goes is caught by spam filters. (4) Click "Sign in"


Change Your Password



You will immediately be asked to update your profile. You don't need to add anything except please DO change your password to something you can remember! (1) Enter your new password and then scroll to the bottom of the page and click "OK." You may be prompted to enter a first and last name before clicking "OK."




