Campus-Wide Updates:

- President Pitney approved the <u>Educational attainment</u> document. This document was approved by the President and shared with the Board. Awards can only be made once per year (they don't stack). If someone received a credential in both 20-21 and 21-22, they would get only one bump. UA HR anticipates having a UA-wide process for this in mid-September. While we wait for the more developed plan and process in the UA System, UAS has broadened the existing pilot in Administrative Services to the rest of UAS. To qualify, employees must have a performance review completed within the past year. Staff who qualify should provide a copy of their transcript showing their credential to their Executive Cabinet member who will confirm eligibility. Once this is done, their department can submit a revised job form to HR to get their pay adjusted.
