Staff Health Care Committee, Staff Alliance (Jessica and Kelly)

- The Joint Health Care Committee (JHCC) voted to recommend that UA eliminate the wellness rebate and points structure from the wellness plan. The vote was 6 union members in favor and 4 Management/Staff members opposed.
- The Staff Health Care Committee met and would like Staff Alliance to advocate to the President and CHRO to **not** accept the JHCC recommendations.
- The second request is that Staff Alliance ask UA to review the JHCC membership and adjust seats to better represent the health plan members. This may require union contract renegotiation. For example, the Local 6070 has the same number of seats as Staff Alliance when staff alliance represents a far larger number of employees. Unions on the JHCC have an outsized voting presence on the committee. While the SHCC does

not want to marginalize any JHCC member, their representation should be more proportional.
