- 4. IT/Technology Governance

  - o Google Fileshare: Share out the google fileshare/resources/shared email docs.
  - Course Archiving: Share out course archiving supplementary doc.
  - Student VDI now win10, single pool.
  - Cisco phone upgrade improved voicemail performance. Other decisions on implementation – will have notification with attachment, 14 day retention on phone. Also, Meet Me function to allow for each staff member to have their own conference number & pin for meetings. Not intended for classes.

4. IT/Technology Governance – **Blackboard Workgroup** Kimberly, Ingman, Susie, Cody, Maureen. Deal with LMS and other issues. **Regional TLTR** reports to Faculty Senate (at every meeting) and to Provost. **eLearning group** is being formed from Strategic Pathways. **ITC** including Vice Chancellors. **CMT** (CIO Management Team) Michael, Martha Mason, Adam in Anchorage, Karl Kowalski.

5. Regional Technology Updates – **Kaltura** (Cody and Maureen). A video management and authoring system, integrated with BlackBoard. Want to put into use for our faculty. KPC is using it as well as some other campuses. More secure than using Screencast or YouTube. Can embed videos. Students can create videos. We have a semester long trial... if we can use a portion of the UAA / UAF license (they have signed a 5 year contract already). It is expensive so we want to make sure that it will be useful to a large enough contingent of faculty before we commit.

6. Upcoming Topics – **Helpdesk/IT Update**: (Cody Bennett) – it has been busy this start of semester. Google environment, fileshare functionality. Google resource calendars with an institutional non-expiring account (testing). Google Backup – can make course backups on Google Drive. Weekly archive. Own conference numbers system for audioconferencing (not for classes) ideal tool for university staff communication. Employee virtual environment (virtual computer lab) to have a virtual computer on the cloud. Employee environment, Windows 10, 8G Ram, can use the UAS software build. ELMO new look from over the summer. Phone system – email to inbox hear the recording, eventually no red light on phone.

# Sept 14 2017 – updates for TLTR (by Maureen O'Halloran)

### Kaltura Update

Kaltura is a video hosting and authoring system which integrates with Blackboard. It provides video hosting, an authoring tool for creating combined PowerPoint/webcam presentations, a screen-capture tool and a video-quiz creation tool. These tools may be used by both faculty and students. It has tools for basic video editing and closed captioning. When used within Blackboard it provides better compliance with copyright and FERPA by truly restricting access to you class, provides statistics so that instuctors can track who has viewed videos (and how much of the video they have watched) and allows video-quiz results to go into the grade center.

Both UAA and UAF have already adopted Kaltura and the license is large enough that adding UAS does not change number of seats. Because of this they have agreed to activate Kaltura for UAS as a free trial and this will happen within a few days. UAS will use this semester to evaluate Kaltura and to encourage faculty to create content or assignments for students. CELT instructional design will actively seek adopters and provide training and support.
